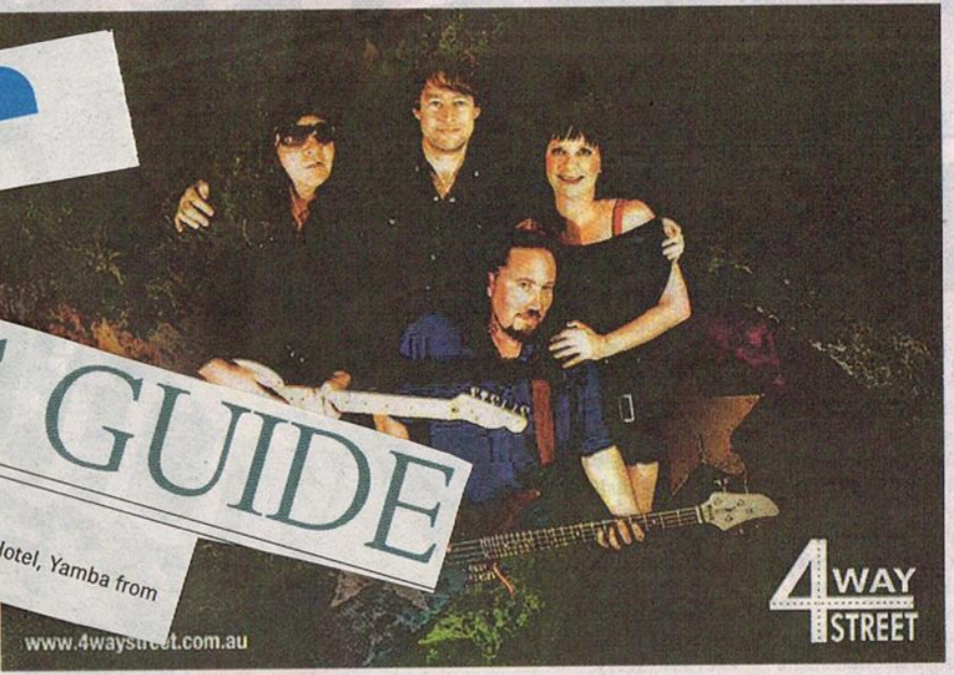

Four ways to rock out

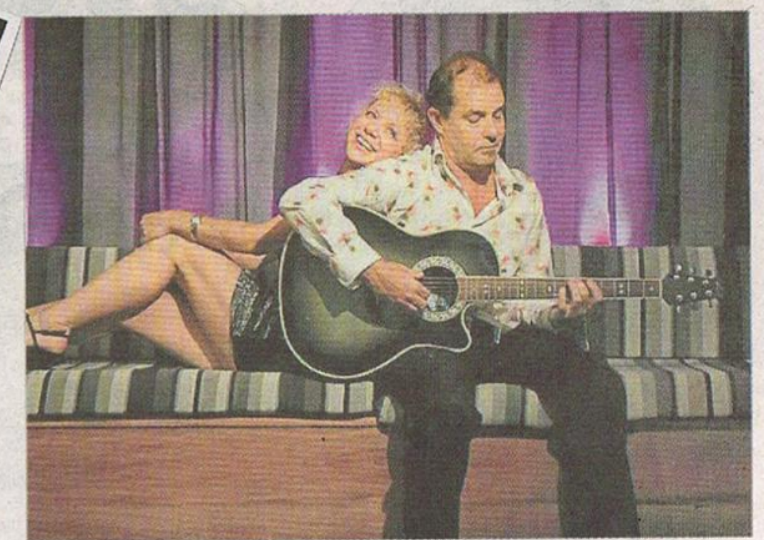


4 Way Street, one of the hardest working cover and original bands on the north coast music scene since forming in 2009, rocks the Harwood Hotel this Friday night.
